The Grand National Meeting, held annually in April, is Britain's most infamous racing event. The shocking spectacle is renowned for killing horses. **Ban the Grand National.**

Approximately 200 horses are killed due to racing in Great Britain each year.

Racing's regulator, the British Horseracing Authority, has attempted to avoid criticism over its poor record on race horse welfare by creating its own welfare body – which consists mainly of racing industry insiders. However, horses continue to be abused with the whip, injured, or killed due to racing or training. Many horses do not enjoy a happy retirement when their racing career is over, and can suffer a downward spiral of neglect, ending at the slaughterhouse.

TAKE ACTION!

Animal Aid is calling for a new, genuinely independent welfare body to be established which reports to the government and to the public - rather than just to the racing industry. This new organisation would hold the racing industry to account and force it to take action to reduce race horse abuse and deaths. More than 100,000 people signed a government petition backing this aim.
