Unhappy Christmas for reindeer

Reindeer are semi-wild animals and should be roaming the tundra...



Research from the Veterinary Laboratories Agency shows that a bad diet, exposure to disease and the stress of being removed from their natural environment has contributed to the deaths of young reindeer in the UK. Government figures show that from 2014 to 2017, a total of 571 reindeer were imported into the UK, from places such as Sweden, Finland and Norway.

Animal Aid has investigated reindeer farms in the UK and found shocking suffering. We witnessed:

- Reindeer suffering from extensive fur loss with raw-looking exposed skin
- 🎤 Animals with heavy diarrhoea
- Some reindeer crowded into night pens or sheds.
- Animals stuck out on a concrete yard with no opportunity to graze
- And worst of all, deliberate abuse. Our covert cameras captured a worker kicking and shouting at reindeer.
